Constitution of India—Article 226—District Collector rejected the claim for compensation on the ground that bunk shop of petitioner is situate in 'puramboke' area—Petitioner treated as 'encroacher' and compensation restricted to 30,000— A Bunk owner who was conducting bunk shop in the puramboke land owned by the Corporation, on the strength of a licence issued by it, cannot be characterised as an 'encroacher'— Position is totally different when Government land is in possession of a person based on a licence/permission—Government order dated 29.12.2017 issued for giving better compensation—Petitioner entitled to higher compensation - Laiju M.S. v. District Collector, Ernakulam and others - I.L.R. 2026 Kerala OnLine 128 : [Neutral Citation No.2026:KER:29986.](#)

Constitution of India—Article 226—Locus standi—Petitioner who is seeking repatriation of mortal remain is not a legal heir of the deceased—Failure of Mother/Daughter of deceased to approach the Court is fatal to the claim - Hans Joseph v. Constitution of India—Article 226—Procedure/Rules/Parameters of every embassy might vary—Embassy has the discretion to frame their own guidelines regarding a matter, taking into consideration relevant laws, geopolitical relationship and other appropriate factors associated with the host country - Hans Joseph v. Constitution of India—Article 226—Writ Petition filed seeking directions for repatriation of the mortal remains to India—Deceased, a British citizen, holds neither the Indian passport nor Overseas Citizen of India (OCI) / Person of Indian Origin (PIO) card—Transfer of mortal remains cannot be at the wish or desire of any successor or legal heir of the deceased—Eligibility to transfer the mortal remains of a dead person has to be decided on the basis of citizenship and relevant rules in force - Hans Joseph v. Union of India and others - I.L.R. 2026 Kerala OnLine 127 : [Neutral Citation No.2026:KER:28947](#).

Disaster Management Act, 2005 (Central Act 53 of 2005)—Sections 25, 26 and 30—Chairperson cannot usurp the powers vested with the Disaster Management Authority under Section 30(2)(v)—Powers of the District Authority is only to give necessary directions to the competent district level authority to take such measure, and not to take such measure directly by the District Authority—To invoke the powers under Section 26(2), the situation should be a real emergency, wherein the convening of a meeting by the District Authority is a practical impossibility - Sreerosh Developers Private Limited v. Employee's Compensation Act, 1923 (Central Act 8 of 1923)—Sections 2, 3, 4 and 5—Power of the Commissioner to award just and proper compensation is not circumscribed by the amount claimed in the application for compensation—Just and proportionate compensation in accordance with the provisions of the Act can be awarded even if the monthly wages proved before the Commissioner is higher than the amount notified by the Government—Section 4 (1B) enable the Government to fix the monthly wages from time to time in order to ensure that employees/dependants seeking compensation under the Act would be entitled for reasonable compensation even if they fail to adduce reliable evidence regarding the actual monthly wages—Benefits granted under Section 47 of the Persons with Disabilities Act, 1995 would not preclude the respondent from claiming benefits

under the Employees' Compensation Act—Persons with Disabilities (Equal Opportunities, Protection of Rights and Full Participation) Act, 1995 (Central Act 1 of 1996)—Section 47 - Chairman and Managing Director, Kerala State Electricity Board Ltd.

Legal Service Authorities Act, 1987 (Central Act 39 of 1987)—Section 19(5)(ii)—When the petitioners themselves admit that there was no coercion for their appearance and they were accompanied by a lawyer, the allegation of fraud will not stand—Section 19(5) does not deal with 'pecuniary jurisdiction' and it only talks about "territorial jurisdiction"- Prasanth P. Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (Central Act 59 of 1988)—Section 169 - Loss of consortium & Loss of love and affection—Once compensation is awarded under the head 'loss of consortium', no amount shall be awarded under the head 'loss of love and affection' - Manjumol K.G. v. Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (Central Act 59 of 1988)—Section 169— Compensation under conventional heads ought to have been fixed at 15,000/- each and further, 10% enhancement has to be given for block of three years from 2017 - Manjumol K.G. v. Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (Central Act 59 of 1988)—Section 169—Loss of dependency—Widow's employment status and re-marriage post death of victim—Claimant/Widow was at a young age at the time of accident and is entitled to loss of dependency, irrespective of employment status—Tribunal cannot disentitle a widow on account of her remarriage—Material date for deciding the compensation is the date of accident/death - Manjumol K.G. v. New India Assurance Co. Ltd. - I.L.R. 2026 Kerala OnLine 126 : [Neutral Citation No.2026:KER:18997.](#)

Securitisation and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest Act, 2002 (Central Act 54 of 2002)—Overdue loan—Instalment facility—Regularisation of account—Directions issued - Shamna C.K. and another v. Manappuram Home Finance Ltd. - I.L.R. 2026 Kerala OnLine 130 : [Neutral Citation No. 2026:KER:31119.](#)

Stamp Act, 1959 (Kerala Act 17 of 1959)—Schedule, Articles 5 (g) and 6—An agreement of hypothecation executed by the loanee after the loan is sanctioned is not liable to be stamped as per Article 6—It need be stamped only as an agreement, liable to stamp duty as per Article 5 (g)- Kerala Gramin Bank v. Saifudheen M. and others - I.L.R. 2026 Kerala OnLine 134 : [Neutral Citation No.2026:KER:31931](#).

Value Added Tax Act, 2003 (Kerala Act 30 of 2004)—Section 6—First Schedule, Entries 18 and 55—Every classification ought to be supported by intelligible differentia; while, such must also have a definitive objective—When Entry No.55 of the First Schedule of the 'KVAT Act' specifically includes 'products' that are notified by the Khadi and Village Industries Commission and manufactured by the Units approved by the 'Boards' and the 'Commission', the fundamental desideratum is that all such products should obtain the benefits thereunder— The word 'pottery' accepts into its fold all articles 'made of clay and hardened by heat', when it is used in the contextual ambit of Entry No.55 of the First Schedule of the 'KVAT Act'—Khadi and Village Industries Board Act, 1957 (Kerala Act 9 of 1957)—Section 15 - M/s. Annammanada Kalimon Vyavasaya Sahakarana Sangham Ltd. v. State of Kerala - I.L.R. 2026 Kerala OnLine 135 : [Neutral Citation No.2026:KER:22514](#).
