**Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 (Central Act 26 of 1996)**—Section 9—Orders for enforcement of a protection order given under Section 9(1) would continue to be an order under Section 9 (1)—The Statute does not contemplate any limit regarding the above extension - God's Own Country Health Resorts International Pvt. **Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (Central Act 46 of 2023)**—Section 482—Factors to be kept in mind while considering application for pre-arrest bail, elucidated—Where two adults voluntarily consent to engage in sexual relations and continue such activity over a prolonged period, it can only be construed as an act of mutual choice or promiscuity, not as sexual assault by one partner against the other—Moral virtues or lack of them in a person accused of an offence cannot be the criterion for determining the legality of any issue raised against him before a court of law—Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (Central Act 2 of 1974)—Section 438—Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 (Central Act 45 of 2023)—Sections 64(2), 89, 115(2) and 351(3) read with Section 3(5) - Rahul B.R. v. **Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (Central Act. 46 of 2023)**—Section 483—Arrest will be vitiated if grounds of arrest is not communicated to relatives of the accused - Ashique v. State of Kerala - I.L.R. 2026 Kerala OnLine 80 : [Neutral Citation No.2026:KER:19267](#).

**Companies Act, 2013 (Central Act 18 of 2013)**—Section 403—Immunity certificate granted under the scheme grants protection from prosecution and penalty alone - Companies Fresh Start Scheme, 2020—Clause 6 (iv) - Sanoo M. **Companies Act, 2013 (Central Act 18 of 2013)**—Sections 152 (3) and 164(1)(h)—Having a DIN is a pre-condition for appointment as a Director—None of the appointments of the Directors of the Yogam after 2014 are in accordance with the provisions of the statute and the appointments are illegal - Sanoo M. **Companies Act, 2013 (Central Act 18 of 2013)**—Sections 152 (3) and 167(1) (a)—A person who is appointed as a Director without complying with Section 152(3) will vacate the office by operation of Section 167(1) (a) - Sanoo M. **Companies Act, 2013 (Central Act 18 of 2013)**—Sections 164 (2) and 460—Power to condone delay in filing returns—By condoning the delay in filing returns, the Central Government cannot undo the disqualification of director incurred by operation of law—Neither the condonation of delay under Section 460 nor the filing of returns under CFSS can obliterate these personal legal consequences—Companies Fresh Start Scheme, 2020 - Sanoo M. **Non-Trading Companies Act, 1961 (Kerala Act 42 of 1961)**—SNDP Yogam is governed by the Kerala Act and not by the Central Act—Companies Act, 2013 (Central Act 18 of 2013) - Sanoo M. K. **Partition**—Undertaking of defendant to pay an unspecified amount of money to the plaintiff when property is sold at an uncertain date—Such an undertaking cannot take away the right of the plaintiff to seek partition—Contract Act, 1872 (Central Act 9 of 1872)—Sections 29 and 35 - Sheno Sebastian v. **Protection of River Banks and Regulation of Removal of Sand Act, 2001 (Kerala Act 18 of 2001)**—Sections 20, 22, and 23—Offence of theft of river sand—A person can be prosecuted for illegal removal or transportation of river sand for the offence of theft under Section 303(2) or 305(e) of the BNS in addition to the offence under Section 23 read with Section 20 of the Sand Act—Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 (Central Act 46 of 2023)—Sections 303(2) and 305(e)—General Clauses Act, 1897 (Central Act 10 of 1897)—Section 26 - Vineesh v. State of Kerala - I.L.R. 2026 Kerala OnLine 81 : [Neutral Citation No.2026:KER:20618.](#)

**Service**—Show-cause notice will have to be issued to the employee wherever it is possible, before declaring him to be ‘ceased to be in service’—Order under Chapter 2, Rule 8 of Mathilakam Rules, shall not attach any stigma, since no disciplinary enquiry is conducted therein—When findings are stigmatic in the termination order, the same could not have been made otherwise than through a confronted enquiry conducted in compliance of the well settled principles of natural justice—Mathilakam Service Rules, 1963—Chapter 2, Rule 8 - Babilu Sankar v.
